 * Became just the 11th trainer to win the Triple Crown, saddling American Pharoah to the first sweep of the series in 37 years in 2015

* Won back-to-back Breeders' Cup Classics with Bayern in 2014 and American Pharoah in 2015
 * Entered the Hall of Fame in August 2009
 * Eclipse Award as Top Trainer in 2015 and 1997-99
 * Leading trainer by earnings 1998-2001
 * Won the Dubai World Cup with Captain Steve in 2001 and Silver Charm in 1998
 * Prior to American Pharoah, brought three colts to the brink of the Triple Crown: Kentucky Derby/Preakness winners Silver Charm (1997); Real Quiet (1998), and War Emblem (2002)
 * Won the Preakness Stakes, Belmont Stakes, Haskell and Travers with Point Given in 2001

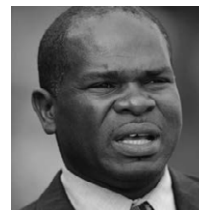

**PATRICK KELLY**

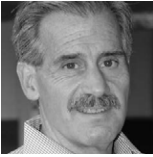
