CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

* Entered the Hall of Fame in August 2009
* Became just the 11th trainer to win the Triple Crown, saddling American Pharoah to the first sweep of the series in 37 years in 2015
* Won his second straight Travers in 2017, his third overall, with eventual 3-Year-Old Champion West Coast, one year after Arrogate upset the Travers at 11-1
* Won three Breeders’ Cup Classics in a row with Bayern in 2014, American Pharoah in 2015, and Arrogate in 2016
* Eclipse Award as Top Trainer in 2015 and 1997-99
* Leading trainer by earnings 1998-2001
* Won the Dubai World Cup with Arrogate in 2017, Captain Steve in 2001, and Silver Charm in 1998
* Prior to American Pharoah, brought three colts to the brink of the Triple Crown: Kentucky Derby/Preakness winners Silver Charm (1997); Real Quiet (1998), and War Emblem (2002)

* Won the Preakness Stakes, Belmont Stakes, Haskell and Travers with Point Given in 2001
* Thirty Slews, the first thoroughbred yearling he purchased at auction, became his first Breeders’ Cup starter and winner (1992 Sprint)




